If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Exhibitors Must Be Governed by Any Rules or Regulations of civil authorities, the I-X Center, the Crown Classic Show Committee and/or building or location restrictions. **Dogs Must be Ready for Judging.** The Club will not be responsible and is not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. **All Dogs Present must be Held on Leash** or confined to their crates except when being judged or in the warm-up area. .

NO GROOMING will be allowed in the agility crating area.

Due to possible crating space limitations, exhibitors might need to consolidate their crating space.

I-X CENTER PARKING RATES

There will be a daily parking fee charged by the I-X Center. All parking rates are established and collected by the I-X Center. Parking is \$8.00 per car each day. A weekend pass is available for \$32.00 (includes Wednesday, if needed).

CLASSES OFFERED

All regular and preferred Standard and JWW will be offered on all days. In addition FAST classes will be offered on Thursday. Please consult AKC rules and regulations pertaining to Agility Trials for complete description and eligibility for entry in these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class/division.

PRIZES and AWARDS

Rosettes and a stuffed dog toy (value \$1-\$3) will be awarded for each qualifying score in all classes. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. A rosette will be given to those finishing an agility title. Those finishing a MACH Title will be presented with a special Rosette and MACH bar. All ribbons/rosettes & prizes must be claimed at the trial, none will be mailed

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. All dogs except 24" must be measured before being shown if a height card has not been presented. If a rep or VMO is present than all dogs must show a card or be measured.

OBSTACLES

All obstacles and equipment used at this trial meet the requirements for agility trials.

AGILITY REGULATIONS

Express Mail Entries *must* include signature permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without recipient's signature. If no recipient is present to sign receipt, entries may be returned to the sender.

Bitches in Season will not be admitted to the Trial. Any Exhibitor with a bitch entered, which is in season on the Trial date, will be refunded the entry fee, less \$10.00 (for each day entered), upon written certification by a Veterinarian. Notification must be in the hands of the Trial Secretary not later than 9:00 AM on the day of the Trial.

Make Checks and Money Orders Payable (for all 4 trials) to **Countryside Agility CANADIAN Exhibitors** must make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS./WRKC assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.

Post Dated or Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretary will add a collection fee of \$20.00 to the amount of each returned check.

No Entry Shall be Made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Errors on Entry Forms. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Please TYPE or **Print Carefully** the information on entry forms to eliminate errors.

PLEASE include instructions as to what you wish to do with your entry if you can not get in all the classes and days you entered.

Entries Will Be Acknowledged as soon as possible after the entry is received if you include a legible e-mail address or postcard. **Entries Will Be Acknowledged After Entries Close** with identification cards and Judging Program. Should such acknowledgment not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Secretary.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have AKC Limited Registration, or are of a registerable breed that have obtained an AKC ILP/PAL number. Dogs eligible for entry in the Miscellaneous Class at dog shows are eligible to participate. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs that are blind or deaf or suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect its physical or mental performance are not eligible to participate.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.**

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes and the FAST titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
