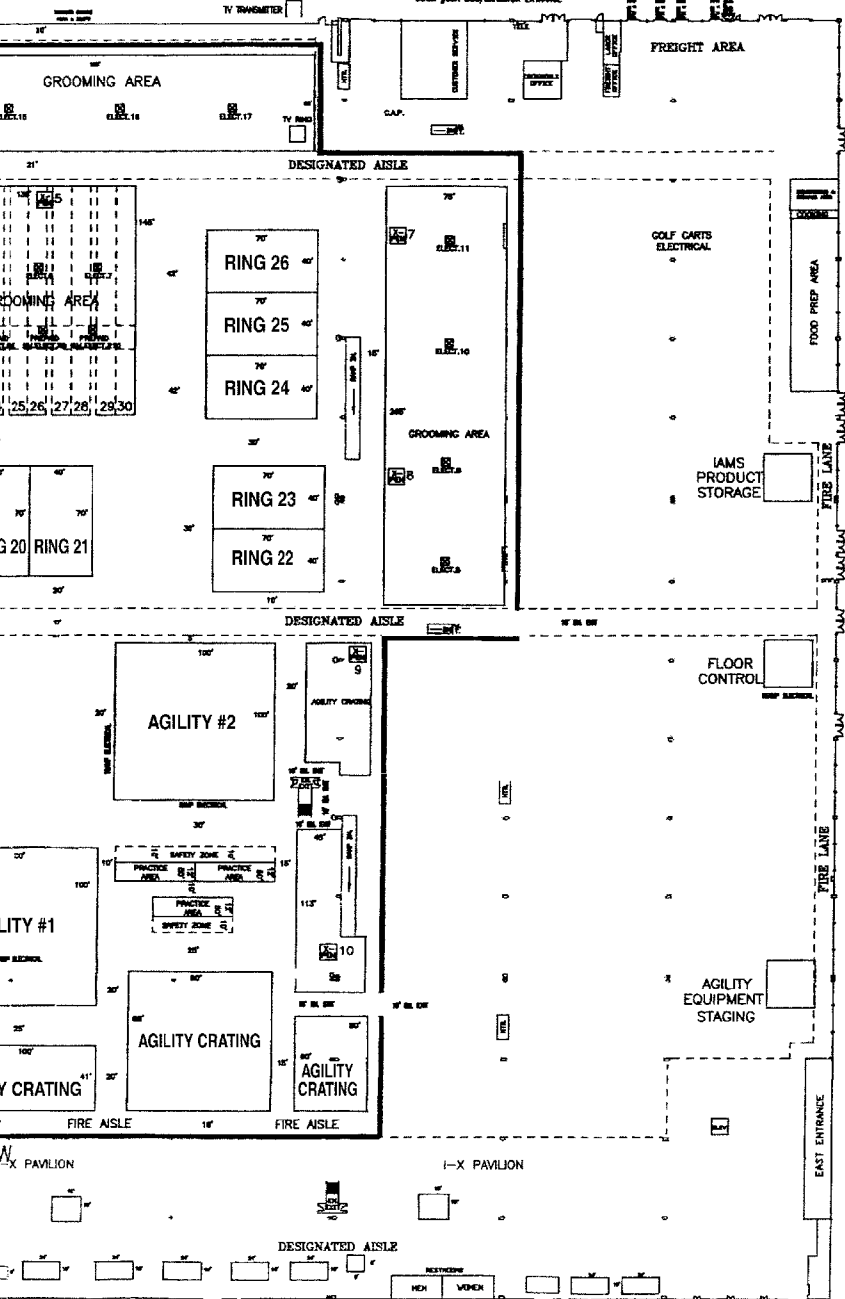

5. Due to the severe clogging problems with the drain pipes, no dog may be bathed in the hotel.
6. Rooms will be inspected daily by members of the hotel staff & observed violations or damages will be reported to the hotel management and/or the Crown Classic Committee.
7. The Crown Classic Committee, working with a fair & equitable system, is charged with investigating complaints.
8. Each dog owner/registrant is expected to cooperate with the Crown Classic Committee, hopefully settling damage claims on the spot, or else must be willing to furnish information such as insurance policy numbers & other pertinent information as required/ requested.
9. Should a hotel/motel, for cause, deem it necessary to cancel room privileges, the registrant agrees to forego legal actions against CLUSTER CLUBS & the hotel/motel.
10. As an exhibitor, I am aware that violations may be referred to the **Event Committee** if written charges are incurred. If such charges are upheld by the **Event Committee**, it may lead to suspension from future show privileges.
11. Motel/hotels have the right to charge a deposit (refundable or non-refundable).

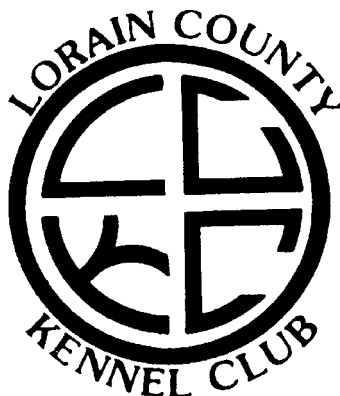

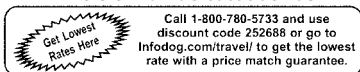

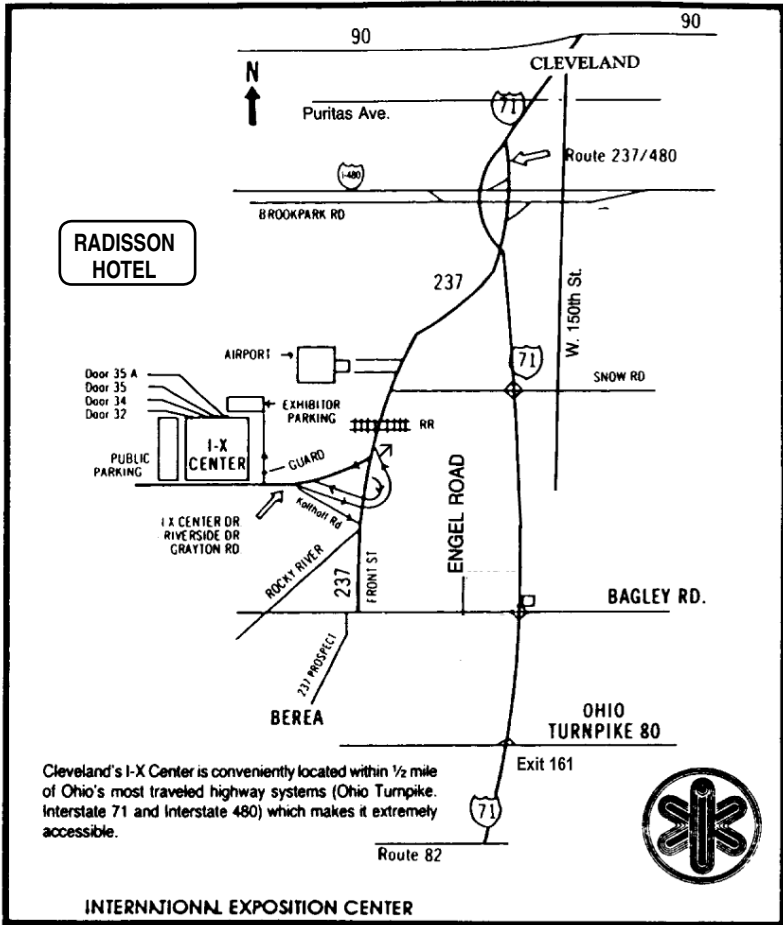
